 - travel difficult




Romulus & Remus

• Rome built across 7 hills

- Latium Plain: City of Rome grew here
 - Tiber River runs though it
 - Fertile land; ash from inactive volcanoes





- Wheat, beans, cabbage, lettuce, figs
- Most **important**: grapes
 - to make wine
 - used wine to pour into cuts and wounds






2 groups of citizens:

- 1. Plebeians: the "ordinary Joe's"
- 2. Patricians: Nobles

Roman King overthrown and patricians took power

- New government:republic
 - Chose representatives to act for them



3 Branches of Government

Consuls

- Army commanders
 - Powerful judges
- Could propose new laws

Senators

- Most powerful branch
- Controlled money of Rome

Tribunes


- Led the citizens assembly
- •Worked to gain rights for the Plebeians

Citizen Assembly (All Citizens)

Could veto/stop Consuls' actions

The Twelve Tables

- written collection of laws
- governed everything from marriage to slavery
- Posted in the Forum: center of all civic life



Rome vs. Garthage

- Romans fought with Carthage for control of Sicily
 - Carthage (Africa)
 - Punic Wars: over 20 years
 - Carthage surrendered Sicily
- Carthage Mad!!! *Hannibal's Plan:*
 - Marched from Spain to Rome: 90,000 men & elephants
 - Hannibal defeated at the Battle of Zama in 202 BC
