Archdiocesan Assessment: History Hall of Fame

Task: Select a **positive** historical leader to induct into the History Hall of Fame and analyze his/her influence on society. **Guidelines:**

- 1. Choose a leader; must be approved by Mrs. Howard (Suggestions on Pg. 3 and 4 of this document)
- You are not allowed to research your Confirmation Saint.
- 2. Research the leader and write a 2-3 page paper in the form of a Time Magazine Article that focuses on the leader's influence. The report should include the following biographical information about the leader:
 - Early & Personal Life (Family, education, etc.)
 - · Political/Religious views of the leader
 - Challenges faced by the leader and how they overcame them
 - Contributions made by the leader
 - Include a quote from the person and reflect on its meaning
 - You will specifically state how the person has impacted society → WHY should they be in the Hall of Fame?
- 3. Magazine Article/Research Paper Requirements: Test Grade for English
 - 10-12 Point Font (Times New Roman or Arial)
 - 2-3 Pages
 - Paragraphs should be well-constructed (Intro, Body, Conclusion)
 - Please proofread for grammatical and spelling errors
 - Bibliography must have a minimum of 4 reputable sources; all sources must be cited using MLA Format
 - Bibliography does not count as a page
 - Paper MUST be submitted on Google Classroom; and a hard copy please.
- 4. Animoto Project & Presentation: Test Grade for Social Studies
 - Presentation must demonstrate how the leader influenced society
 - · Include important elements to teach the class about the leader's life
 - Research report is NOT to be read during the presentation
 - Presentation should include music and a minimum of 5 pictures that are RELEVANT to the topic
 - The video should be neat and organized (misspelled words should be avoided)

Presentation to the Class:

- Prior to showing the Animoto video students will provide a 2-4 minute speech introducing the leader and sharing with the class why they should be inducted into the Hall of Fame.
- Note Cards are strongly recommended
- Please do not read directly from your research paper
- Please use adequate eye contact, volume, and maintain good posture

We can't stress enough to research thoroughly, DIG DEEP! This could range from reading about their personal life to researching fun facts. You will be the expert in the room on the specific person you chose, so be prepared to answer questions after your presentation. In addition, please choose someone that you find INTERESTING. If you begin researching a figure that you find is not for you please let Mrs. Howard know ASAP. There will be additional assignments due prior to the paper and presentation. Please see the next page for important dates and be on the lookout for documents in Google Classroom. You will be given time to work on this project in Social Studies and English class. However, we strongly encourage you to work on this outside of class as well.
