Herbert Hoover

- Republican
- Viewed as uncaring
- Still didn't believe in govt.
 aid

Franklin Delano Roosevelt

- Democrat
- Seemed concerned
- During campaign;
 brainstormed with experts
 how to solve Great
 Depression

WON BY A LANDSLIDE



Advisors

- 1. Picked experienced reformers for his cabinet
- Chose a labor reformer as secretary of Labor (first female)
- 3. Urban reformer for Secretary of the interior
- 4. Placed African Americans in govt. positions
- 5. Wife played an important role





Hundred Days



- Congress met during this time;
 passing FDR's New Deal Programs
 - series of govt. programs
 - Intent: to pull country out of depression
 - create jobs/provide for the people



The New Deal

- Only allowed stable banks to re-open
- Created FDIC: protected bank accounts
- Created Home Owners Loan Corp: offered low interest/long term mortgage rates
- Federal Emergency Relief Admin: gave relief money to the states to distribute
 - By 1935 spent 3 billion
- Civilian Conservation Corps & Civil Works
 Admin: provided jobs

Controversy & The 2nd New Deal

- Critics of New Deal led to a reform→ 2nd New Deal
- 2nd New Deal:
 - Social Security Act; distributes money to retired workers over 65
 - gave insurance to unemployed
 - Benefits to families of male workers who died



- Economy improving but millions still unemployed
- Republican, Alfred Landon runs
 - against many of the New Deal programs; waste of money
- Roosevelt wins

FDR & The Supreme Court

- Supreme Court kept striking down the New Deal
 - Roosevelt tried to increase the number of judges from 9 to 15 ->
 SHUT DOWN
 - next 4 years; 7 justicesdied or retired
 - Roosevelt appointed justices that agreed with New Deal





"Roosevelt Recession"

- Roosevelt tried to reduce federal aid → Economy declines again:
 - 1938 unemployment shoots back up
 - Roosevelt reinstates aid
- The Depression does not end until WW2 hit
 - due to wartime production
