DUE: Tuesday, January 19

- Research quotes by the historical person you chose for the History Hall of Fame Assessment
- Choose one quote that is most **meaningful** to you and create a fake tweet using a Google Drawing template
- Reflect on this quote in a written response (Google Classroom Assignment)

Requirements for Tweet

1. Profile Name/Username

- You will identify the person by first and last name and create a username
→@createusername
- The username must be **unique** and be **relevant** to the person

2. Profile Image

- Tweet will include a **quality** profile picture—avoid blurry images
- Color or a black and white photograph is acceptable
- The easiest way to accomplish this: Right click on sample photo (control+click)→ select replace image → Google search your person and select the photo of your choice.

3. Message

- Type the quote you have chosen as your message.
- Create a hashtag **and/or** tag someone
- Depending on the length of the quote, you may have to adjust the font size to fill the space appropriately.
- Do NOT change the font color or font type of the profile name or quote. If you plan to print in color and you would like to change the hashtag/tag color to blue (to look more accurate) you can do that.
- Make sure words are spelled correctly and that proper punctuation is used.
- You do not need to put quotations around the quote—since the objective is to create a fake tweet from that person.

4. Date & Time

- At the bottom of the document update the date and time.
- The date needs to be appropriate to the time period the person lived/lives in.

*****You must turn in a hard copy of your tweet. Tweets will be displayed in the classroom.*****

- Google Classroom Assignment: Follow the directions in this document that will require you to reflect on the meaning of the chosen quote. This part only needs to be turned in on Google Classroom.
